Over 10 years Catchment Sensitive Farming (CSF):

- Continues to provide where English farmer holdings are linked to diffuse pollution from agriculture,
- Advice, training and grants,
- To adopt better farm practice and
- Help change farmer /adviser attitudes and behaviour.
- CSF funding is from the UK Government
- With funding from the European Commission for grants.
- So installations must comply with EC rules,
- Linked to other EC rural payments for farmers, to ensure specifications are met.












Countryside Stewardship on Magic for Essex













Countryside Stewardship Offers include:-

Offer	Features
Capital Items Only	 Two year agreement Max £10K per holding in a year March- 30 Sept'16 application window. 2 years to complete work
Capital and land management agreement – Mid or Higher Tier	 5 year agreement. 2 year capital works (early in agreement) Multiple objectives (where targeting dictates) No cap on value











CSF Officer Endorsement of Middle Tier and Water Grants

- before and after a Countryside Stewardship application will increase its score and chance of success.

Can only happen if an application is from Water Priority Area priority **holding**, which can uplift points scores (by up to 20%) and allows access to the water grants.

Endorsements are only for those farms previously engaged with the CSF project - if not known to CSF, no endorsement offered.










Water Capital Grants <u>not requiring</u> CSF endorsement include RP26 Biofilters @£990/ installation













BEFORE application:-

- Land must be registered before applying
- Farmers need to apply for planning permission and read guidance to see if any other written advice & consents are required i.e. from Environment Agency incl. T32, local Planning Authorities, etc











Which Countryside Stewardship water quality options to choose?

Where targeted in 2013:

- N or P from fertilisers, manures and organic materials, and/ or
- sediment from soil erosion and run-off.
- and/ or
- pesticides from their use and disposal in Drinking Water Safeguard Zones.
