

Motivation and Aim




BCS has a strong interest in reducing pollution of surface water, mainly point contaminations by supporting

- Spreading of knowledge to countries that have not yet done any research in this field










Biobeds 2004







The Mayfair Hotel, Malmö


The building's history dates back to the 13th century.


